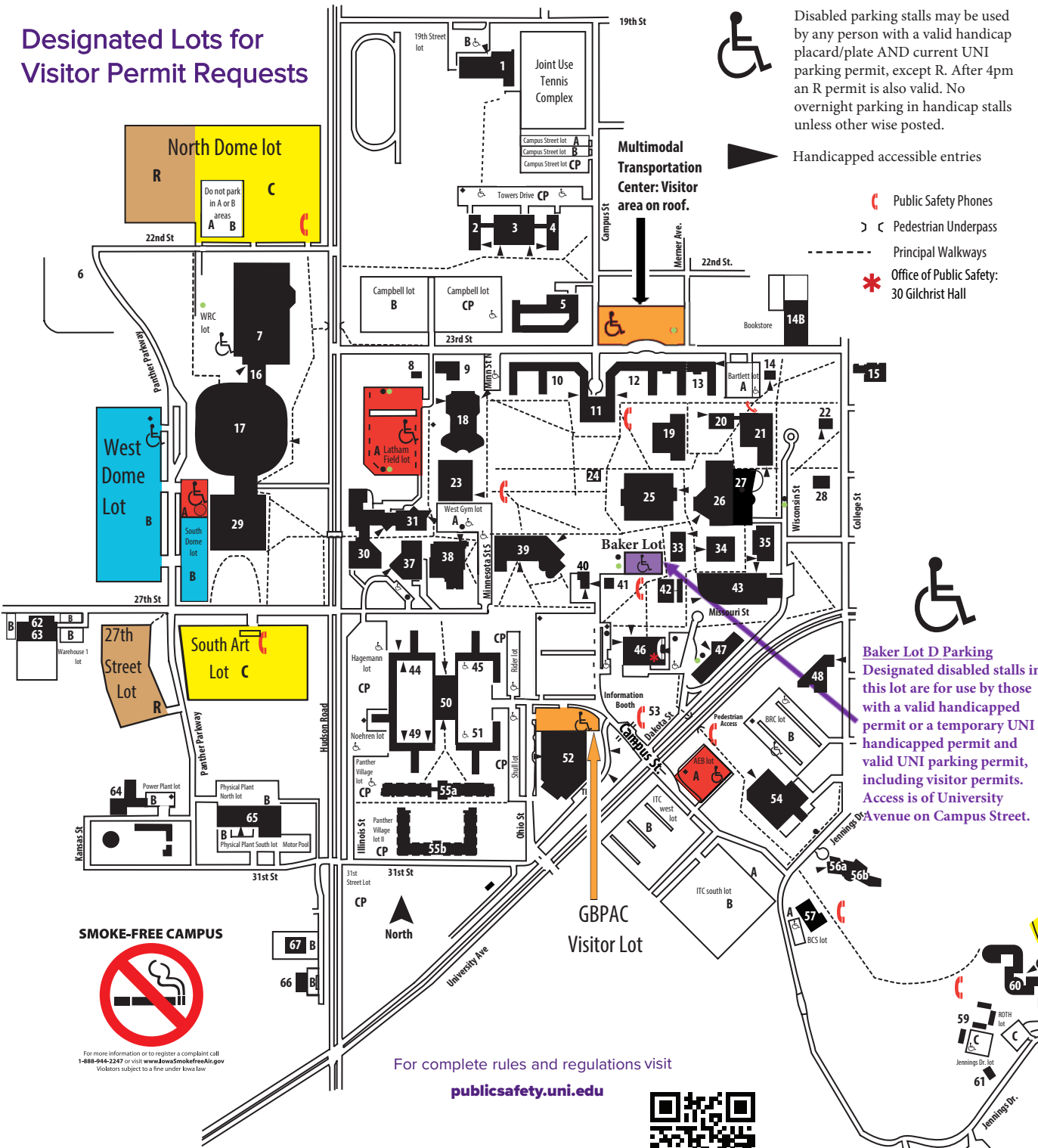


# Designated Lots for Visitor Permit Requests



Disabled parking stalls may be used by any person with a valid handicap placard/plate AND current UNI parking permit, except R. After 4pm an R permit is also valid. No overnight parking in handicap stalls unless otherwise posted.
